The Book of Esther tells the story of a Persian plot against the Jews, who attacked their enemies pre-emptively.“

Really? Personally I’d be surprised if a crack team of Israeli software engineers were so sloppy that they relied on outdated rootkit technology (e.g. hooking the `Nt*()` calls used by [Kernel32.LoadLibrary\(\)](#) and using [UPX](#) to pack code).
