

Space.com: "China's Chang'e-4 <u>lunar rover</u> has discovered an unusually colored, 'gel-like' substance during its exploration activities on the far side of the moon." — "So far, mission scientists haven't offered any indication as to the nature of the colored substance and have said only that it is "gel-like" and has an "unusual color." One possible explanation, outside researchers suggested, is that the substance is melt glass created from meteorites striking the surface of the moon."
